Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 5 and Year 6 World War Two theme day – 7th February

As part of our topic in Y5 and Y6, we are learning about World War 2 and are planning to hold a day of activities based around this. To add to the atmosphere of the day, we would love the children to come dressed in 1940s style clothes.

As a guide, this could include:

Girls	Boys
A cardigan or tank top/jumper;	A v-neck top/shirt;
A floral dress or a skirt or a pinafore and blouse;	Smart shorts;
White knee-length socks or dark tights;	Knee-length socks;
Long hair in two plaits, short hair combed with a centre parting and a head band or ribbon.	Hair combed flat: side or centre parting
Baker boy style hat	Baker boy style hat or flat cap

Alternatively, children could dress as one of the important people of the time e.g. Winston Churchill or as one of the roles we had during the war, such as the Women's Land Army (dungarees/trousers, t-shirt and headscarf), soldier, nurse or Home Guard etc.

We will be sampling some wartime recipes during the day (should the children wish to!) so if there are any food allergies we are not aware of, please let your child's class teacher know so we can adjust recipes accordingly.

There is no cost for the day.
